**MANDATORY ELECTRONIC EVIDENCE SUBMISSION
AND
ELECTRONIC EVIDENCE PRESENTATION**

The United States Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of Tennessee is mandating electronic submission of evidence for use in any trial, hearing or motion docket. Beginning August 1, 2012, all evidence must be submitted using the “Electronic Evidence Submission Application” (EESA) available through CM/ECF. Electronic evidence submission applies to all cases, contested matters and adversary proceedings. Evidence will not be accepted by the Court or Clerk other than through EESA.

Training for electronic evidence will consist of two components: (1) evidence submission through EESA and (2) electronic evidence presentation in the courtroom. It is highly encouraged that Bankruptcy practitioners and their staff learn to submit and present electronic evidence for use in trials, hearings and motion dockets.
