

Pursuant to Rule 9029 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, Rule 9029-1 of the Local Rules of Court for the Middle District of Tennessee is amended by adding a new subsection "c." as follows:

c. **Administrative Procedures for Electronic Case Filing.** The bankruptcy judges of the district are authorized, pursuant to Rule 9029(a)(1) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, to make and amend Administrative Procedures with respect to Electronic Case Filing (ECF) in the Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of Tennessee. Administrative Procedures so enacted shall have the force of local bankruptcy rules but shall be made, amended and applied with due regard for the new and still developing technology that is the ECF system.


