ORDER MODIFYING APPENDIX C OF THE LOCAL RULES OF COURT
(FORM MOTION TO WITHDRAW UNCLAIMED FUNDS)

The United States Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of Tennessee has adopted a financial application (JIFMS) which requires all disbursements be made by ACH (electronic deposit) transaction from the U.S. Treasury. As such, motions for disbursement of unclaimed funds must be accompanied by information which allows the clerk's office to register claimants in the U.S. Treasury's database.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that page 2 of Appendix C of the Local Rules of Court, the form *Motion to Withdraw Unclaimed Funds*, is modified to include the requirement that claimants filing such motions submit the AO Form 213, and page 3 of Appendix C-1, a blank AO Form 213, is added for the convenience of claimants.




