COMING SOON!!!

On February 14, 2022, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Middle District of Tennessee will be upgrading its Legacy CM/ECF to NextGen CM/ECF!

Be prepared – visit www.tnmb.uscourts.gov for details and information.

NextGen simplifies electronic filing by combining your CM/ECF and PACER accounts into a single Central Sign-On account. This single Central Sign-On account gives registered filers access to view documents in PACER and electronically file in all NextGen courts in which users have permission to file.

All e-filers with accounts at TNMB are required to have their **own individual PACER account**.
